From outside a discrete design, inside of great architectural quality, containing rich spatial diversity and character. Spread over three levels, the layout proposes a clear organization of it's program spaces: on the ground level key areas which demand direct access to the public, below car parking and technical spaces, on the first floor the gym and health club... At an urban level, it rationally links the city on each side of the sports center, granting efficient access and distributing traffic between both... The design considers storm and grey water treatment, indoor environmental quality, lighting and mechanical controlability with bms, amongst other strategies that globally promote it's energy efficiency and sustainability." in the jury's final report.
